

High School Varsity Letter Criteria 2026

We will try to work with your school, if not part of HVS, to get you a varsity letter. If we can't get you a varsity letter from your home school, we can get you a Milford varsity letter.

In addition to the Varsity letter criteria below, if a high school student scores points that count for the team total in any race (top 6 pointers) AND the team wins the State Championship, they will receive a Varsity letter, top 3 requirements below still apply.

| Racing | Race and FINISH at least 5 of the 6 races in the MiSCA series. | Finish the race series with an overall placement in the top 20 of a varsity category or the top 10 of a junior varsity category. |
